SAMPLE LANGUAGE FOR CHARITABLE BEQUEST TO AN “AMERICAN FRIENDS OF HARA FUND” AT KBFUS TO BE INCLUDED IN YOUR LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I hereby bequeath:
